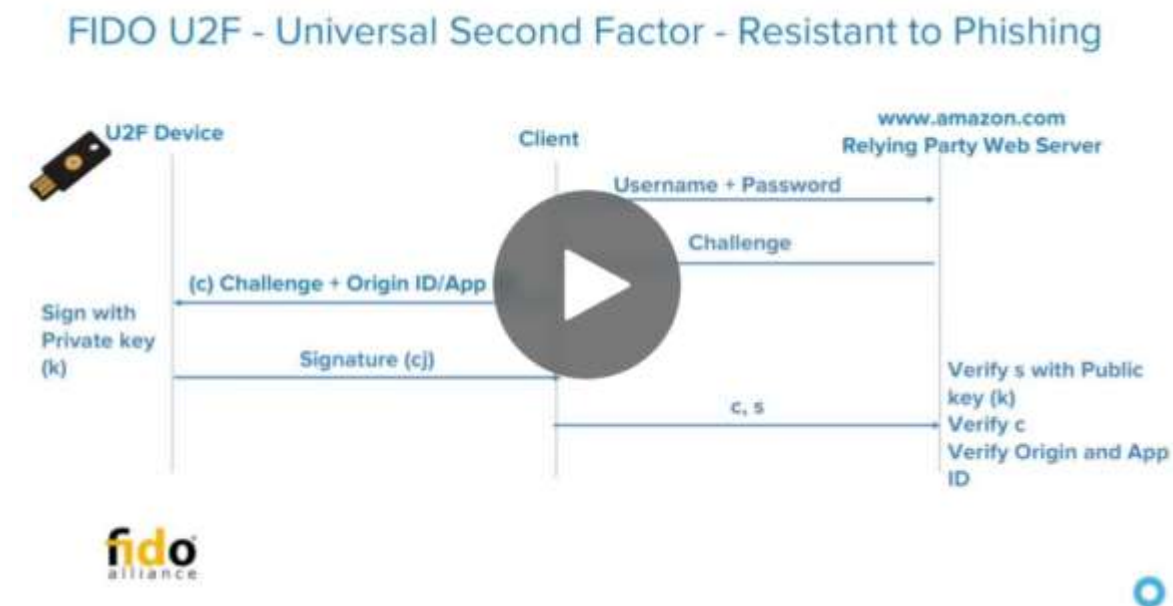


No passwords, no problem: Using WebAuthn to stop account takeover
